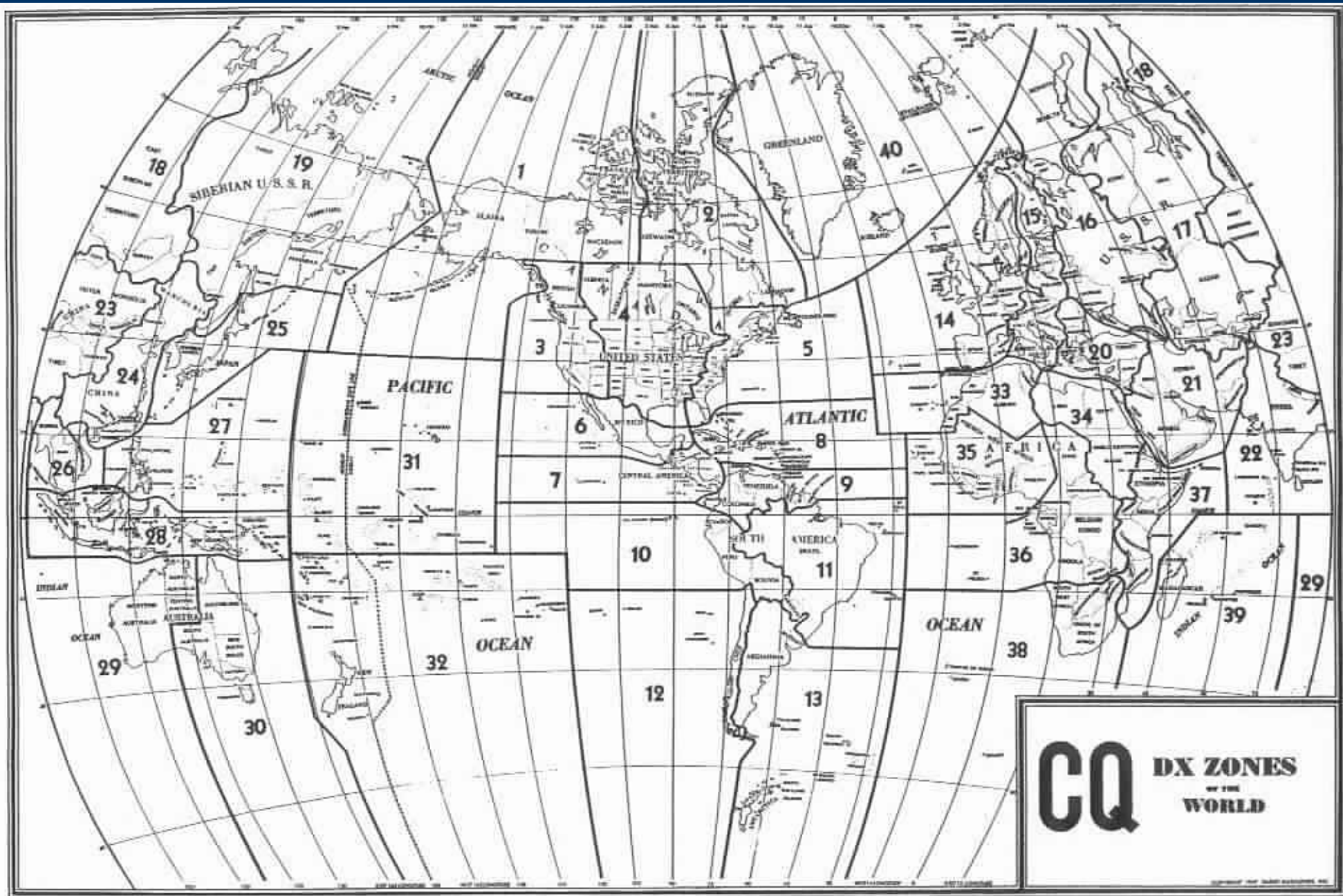

- Make new friends, experience different cultures

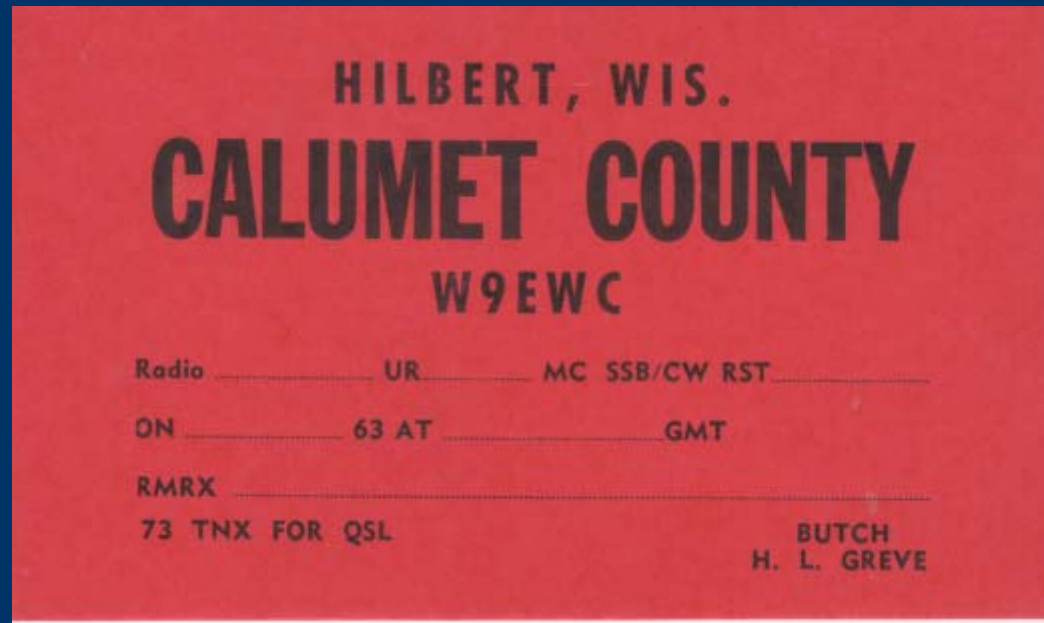
Where did this idea come from?

- Blame your friends: N6AA and N6TJ
- In 1988, I'd operated the contest from 10 zones
- N6TJ operated from D44BC, N6AA from SU1ER
- D44BC: 7.4M SU1ER: 6.1M
- N6TJ claims victory; but so does N6AA
- N6AA had operated the contest from more zones

How long does this take, and how do you do it?

- Minimum of 20 years
- Tradition: Multi-op Phone, Single-op CW
- With Multi-op, you can take antennas
- XYL's and YL's welcome....bring radio gear
- Un-used stations easier to find on CW
- Go to Dayton, Visalia....talk to people
